VISA PROCESS HOW TO APPLY?

International students in the US need two key documents:

- 1. I-20 (document issued by the university).
- 2. F1 Visa (Student Visa, stamped on the passport, issued by the US embassy at the student's country).

When a student has completed the Admissions process, a full semester fee is required to be paid. In order for Schiller International University to issue an I-20.

To receive an I-20, students must send the University "Proof of Sufficient Funds", (minuimum \$34,000).

Visa Application period: Visas for new students can be issued up to 365 days in advance of the start date for a course of study. However, the student will not be allowed to enter the United States on their student visa more than 30 days before the start date.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Complete the Online Visa Application.
- 2. Print the application form confirmation.
- 3. Upload Photo.
- 4. Schedule an appointment for your visa interview at the U.S. Embassy or Consulate in the country where you live.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Passport valid for travel to the United States Your passport must be valid for at least six months beyond your period of stay in the United States (unless exempt by countryspecific agreements). Each individual who needs a visa must submit a separate application, including any family members listed in your passport.
- Nonimmigrant Visa Application, Form DS-160 confirmation page.
- Application fee payment receipt.
- Photo –one printed photo.
- · I-20.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS MAY BE REQUIRED:

- Academic preparation, such as: Transcripts, diplomas, degrees, or certificates from schools you attended.
- Your intent to depart the United States upon completion of the course of study.
- How you will pay all educational, living and travel costs.
