Schiller International University provides complete graduation, retention, and other statistics to the general public, including prospective students, as required by the U.S. Department of Education (“ED”) via the Integrated Postsecondary Educational Data System (“IPEDS”). This is the latest graduation rate based on the IPEDS report. These statistics are for full-time, first-time (“FTFT”) students who began their studies in the Fall of 2017 and graduated within 150% of the “normal time” to complete their program.
